



How to apply for a passport

Passports should have at least **2 blank pages** for entry stamps. The **blank pages can't** include the "endorsement" page.

1 Complete a DHA-73 form at your nearest **Home Affairs office**, or if you're overseas you can visit a **South African embassy** or mission.

2 Make sure you have your official ID or birth certificate for children **under 16 years**.

3 Have your fingerprints taken by **Home Affairs officials**.

4 Confirm with your nearest **Home Affairs office** if you need to bring your **own passport photos** or if they're using the new **biometric application system**.
