



The Heritage Western Cape logo was launched on Saturday, 13 May 2006 by Minister Whitey Jacobs and will be displayed visually at all the newly declared heritage sites in the province and will be a visual symbol of Heritage Western Cape for many years to come.

What does it mean or symbolize:

- The logo attempts to give visual link to the Provincial Logo and yet is still unique. It shows the Western Cape, where the sun sets.
- The logo reflects a blend of intangible heritage and architecture and at the same time has flashes that are reflective of the cultural diversity of the province.
- The blue represents the International Heritage colour.
- The brown/bronze represents earth, palaeontology, rock-art, brick and mortar.
