NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE AWARDS FOR 2010

AWARDS TO SCHOOLS

CATEGORY 1 - EXCELLENCE IN ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

In the category of academic excellence there are two sub-categories: excellence in academic achievement in the context within which the school operates and excellence according to a set of given criteria.

Category 1a: Excellence in academic achievement in the social context within which the school operates

In this category, awards are presented to eight **schools** where the academic performance in 2010 illustrates meritorious outcomes relative to the context within which the school operates and where there is consistency in the number of candidates (at least 90% of the previous 3 years). The 'context within which a school operates' is based on the quintile (1 – 3) and a pass rate of at least 75%. 'Meritorious outcomes' will be based on both **number of candidates that wrote (minimum of 35)** and the number of candidates who obtained the National Senior Certificate with access to Bachelors Degree.

Each school will receive an award of R20 000 for the purchase of teaching and learning support material.

Category 1b: Excellence according to a set of given criteria

In this category, awards are made to the top **ten schools** in the province (including independent schools) that have achieved excellence in academic results in 2010, based on the following criteria:

- (a) Consistency in number of grade 12 candidates over a period of 3 years (at least 90%) of previous years
- (b) an overall pass rate of at least 95% in 2010
- (c) % of candidates with access to Bachelor's degree

Each school will receive an award of R15 000 for the purchase of teaching and learning support material.

Each school will receive an award of R10 000 for the purchase of teaching and learning support material.

CATEGORY 2 – EXCELLENCE AND IMPROVEMENT IN INDIVIDUAL SUBJECTS

Each school will receive an award of R2 500 for the purchase of teaching and learning support material.

Category 2a: Mathematics

Excellence in Mathematics

This is awarded to ONE **school** in the province that excelled by producing the highest number of passes at 30% and above in Mathematics. The school must have a minimum of 35 candidates who wrote Mathematics.

Category 1: Excellent achievement across the province (including Independent Schools)

This is awarded to the **candidates** in the top 20 positions in the province according to the marks obtained in the best **six** subjects that fulfil the requirements for the award of a National Senior Certificate (two Languages, Mathematics and three other subjects excluding Life Orientation).

Each candidate will receive an award of R 3 000 for the purchase of study material as well as free online access to Encyclopedia Britannica sponsored by Sangari South Africa. The top five candidates will each receive a laptop sponsored by MUSTEK.

Category 2: Outstanding achievement within the context of study

This is awarded to the top **20 candidates** according to the marks obtained in the best six subjects that fulfil the requirements for the award of a National Senior Certificate (two Languages, Mathematics / Mathematical Literacy and three other subjects excluding Life Orientation), providing that the candidates will be drawn from the previous education departments and new WCED schools and that the candidates obtain 80% or more in at least two subjects.

Each candidate will receive an award of R 3 000 for the purchase of study material as well as free online access to Encyclopedia Britannica sponsored by Sangari South Africa. The top five candidates will each receive a laptop sponsored by MUSTEK and the remainder 15 learners will each receive a cheque for R 1 165.00 sponsored by Maskew Millar Longman.
