QUARTERLY CONSOLIDATED STATEMENT:  
QUARTER 4 ENDING 30 JUNE 2021 (PRELIMINARY RESULTS)**

I, Mr David Maynier, Provincial MEC for Finance and Economic Opportunities in the Western Cape, in terms of section 71(7) of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act (No. 56 of 2003), publish the consolidated statement on municipal budgets in the Western Cape Province. The consolidated statement reflects the financial performance of municipalities as at the end of the fourth quarter (ending 30 June 2021) of the 2020/21 municipal financial year. The performance reporting for this period presents the 2020/21 preliminary municipal budget performance outcomes and is subject to change with the finalisation of the municipal Annual Financial Statements.

The Provincial Treasury is using the National Treasury Database as the primary source for the information reported in this publication. Although every effort has been made to compile a reliable set of numbers, the quality and completeness of the information is affected by the credibility of reports submitted by municipalities.

## **SUMMARY ON THE STATE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE: FOURTH QUARTER CONSOLIDATED STATEMENT FOR THE PERIOD 1 APRIL 2021 – 30 JUNE 2021 (PRELIMINARY RESULTS)**

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### **BACKGROUND**

Section 71 (7) of the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA) requires that the Provincial Treasury must, within 30 days after the end of each quarter, make public as may be prescribed, a consolidated statement in the prescribed format on the state of municipalities' budgets per municipality and per municipal entity.

This publication forms part of the In-Year Management, Monitoring and Reporting System for Local Government which enables the Provincial Treasury to exercise oversight over municipalities in the Western Cape. It provides a high-level review of the implementation of municipal budgets for the fourth quarter, ending 30 June 2021. The performance reporting for this period presents the 2020/21 preliminary municipal budget performance outcomes and is subject to change with the finalisation of the municipal Annual Financial Statements.

### **DATA USED**

National Treasury's Local Government Database is the primary data source used for this publication. The quality of the report is subject to the credibility of the municipal Standard Chart of Accounts (mSCOA) data string information submitted and is compromised when municipalities fail to submit all the required data strings.

Some anomalies were noted in the submissions made by municipalities which have a significant impact on the credibility of the financial information reported for the period ending 30 June 2021. Discrepancies on key indicators were observed on the negative cash and cash equivalent budgets and year-to-date actuals reported by some municipalities as well as misalignment on capital funding and expenditure.

The following were noted as contributing factors to inconsistencies between the Municipal Budget and Reporting Regulation (MBRR) schedules and mSCOA data strings:

- Incorrect use of movements account in the mSCOA;
- The use of incorrect mSCOA segments;
- Some Municipalities budgeting and transacting outside the core financial system;
- Errors in the linkages of MBRR tables and mSCOA data strings in the National Treasury Database.

The municipal capital and cash flow budget performance presented in this publication may not align to the performance reported by municipalities to their respective Councils in their Financial Management Reports (FMR).

Guidelines were provided to address the above challenges by National Treasury in terms of mSCOA circulars 10 and 11 to improve the credibility of data strings. Improvements are noted in some municipalities cash flow alignment and further improvements can be expected in the 2021/22 budget performance cycle. Western Cape municipalities are committed to improving the quality of financial information with support from National and Provincial Treasury.

The data presented in this gazette provides a summary of budget implementation performance against key indicators for all municipalities in the province. Detailed information for each municipality is available to the public in the section 71 files published at [mfma.treasury.gov.za](http://mfma.treasury.gov.za).

## AGGREGATED TRENDS

1. Preliminary data on financial performance for the 2020/21 municipal financial year indicates that Western Cape municipalities are adjusting to the fiscal impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic. Twenty-three (23) municipalities under recovered on their operating revenue budget due to the on-going effects of the pandemic.
2. Municipalities have responded to this pressure by slowing expenditure where possible. On aggregate, Western Cape municipalities spent 87.6 per cent or R67.86 billion of the total adjusted expenditure budget of R77.46 billion by the end of the municipal financial year on 30 June 2021 (operating expenditure accounted for R60.28 billion and capital expenditure for R7.58 billion).
3. In respect of revenue, aggregate billing and other revenue amounted to 94.1 per cent or R70.18 billion of the total adjusted revenue budget of R74.61 billion (operating revenue accounted for R62.35 billion and capital revenue for R7.83 billion).
4. Aggregate operating revenue for the period ended 30 June 2021 amounted to R62.35 billion or 97.7 per cent of the adjusted operating revenue budget of R63.8 billion, representing a negative variance of 2.3 per cent mainly as a result of under recoveries reported on transfers and subsidies (12.1 per cent), and investment revenue (13.3 per cent).
5. Service charges and property rates are the largest revenue sources, contributing 48 and 21.5 per cent, respectively towards the total adjusted operating revenue budget of R63.8 billion. The 2021 preliminary results show R30.7 billion in revenue generated from service charges (100.2 per cent of the R30.65 billion adjusted budget) and R13.46 billion revenue in property rates (98 per cent of the R13.73 billion adjusted budget). These amounts represent billed revenue and not actual revenue collected. Stringent debt collection strategies must be applied to realise the planned revenue.
6. For the 2020/21 financial year municipalities spent R60.28 billion or 90.7 per cent of their aggregated R66.45 billion operating adjusted expenditure budget. The highest operating expenditure items for the 2020/21 financial year are employee related costs amounting to R20.89 billion followed by materials and bulk purchases of R17.05 billion and other expenditure amounting to R16.13 billion.
7. The year to date operating expenditure for the City of Cape Town (Metro) amounts to R41.6 billion or 93 per cent of their R44.73 billion adjusted expenditure budget. Secondary cities (Drakenstein, George and Stellenbosch municipalities) reported spending of 82.7 per cent or R5.53 billion against their collective adjusted operating expenditure budget of R6.68 billion. District Municipalities reported spending of R1.47 billion or 87.7 per cent against their total adjusted operating budget, while the remaining Local Municipalities spent R11.67 billion or 87.4 per cent against their total adjusted operating budget of R13.35 billion.
8. Western Cape municipalities reflect spending R7.58 billion or 68.9 per cent against the R11.01 billion adjusted capital budget. The capital expenditure amounts reflected in the data strings is lower than the actual capital spending reported by some municipalities in their Financial Management Reports (FMR) that were presented to their respective Councils. These disparities are mainly the result of mSCOA challenges which are still experienced by several municipalities.
9. The City of Cape Town is the largest contributor to the overall capital performance and reported spending of R4.77 billion or 64.2 per cent of their adjusted capital budget of R7.43 billion. This amount is less than the actual performance of 82.3 per cent reported in the municipal MBRR report and the difference is currently being assessed for correction. Secondary cities (Drakenstein, George and Stellenbosch municipalities) reported capital expenditure performance of R713.06 million or 73.1 per cent against their combined adjusted budget of R975.25 million. The capital budget

spending for district municipalities amounted to R17.07 million or 39.6 per cent of their total adjusted budget of R43.10 million and local municipalities' capital spending amounted to R2.09 billion or 81.3 per cent against their R2.57 billion adjusted capital budget. Amongst the contributing factors to under spending are delays in the supply chain processes which were further exacerbated by the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic this year. Capital expenditure is also likely to increase upon the finalization of year-end processes and the Annual Financial Statements.

10. In aggregate, the Western Cape municipalities fund 70.7 per cent of their total planned capital investment from own funding. This is made up of borrowing (5.8 per cent) and internally generated funds (64.9 per cent).
11. Capital spending against borrowings amounted to R438.94 million or 69.7 per cent against the adjusted borrowing budget of R629.69 million. Capital spending funded from transfers recognised amounted to R2.32 billion or 73.2 per cent against the R3.16 billion budgeted. Spending on internally generated funds amounted to R5.08 billion or 72.4 per cent against the R7.02 billion adjusted budget for internally generated funds.
12. Aggregate municipal consumer debtors as at 30 June 2021 amounted to R10.82 billion, which represents a significant decrease of 19.2 per cent from R13.38 billion reported in quarter 3 of 2020/21. The largest share is owed by households, which account for R7.51 billion or 69.5 per cent of the total, noting a decline of 23.2 per cent from the R9.78 billion reported in the previous quarter. Organs of state account for R283.46 million or 2.6 per cent of the total debt.
13. Debtors older than 90 days amount to R7.19 billion or 66.5 per cent of the total outstanding debtors of R10.82 billion which include historic debt that has accumulated over an extended period, interest on arrears and other recoveries. This amount represents a decrease of 30.1 per cent from the R9.43 billion reported in quarter 3 of 2020/21. This decline can be attributed to the write-off of impaired debt by several municipalities in the last quarter.
14. In aggregate, Western Cape municipalities reported preliminary outstanding creditors of R840.38 million as at 30 June 2021. The total outstanding creditors older than 30 days amount to R175.20 million or 20.8 per cent of the total. Municipalities cited various reasons for payments that are owed for more than 30 days.
15. Four (4) municipalities account for most of the outstanding creditor balances over 30 days and bespoke support initiatives and engagements are held with these municipalities.
16. The total cash and cash equivalents reported by municipalities as at the end of quarter 4 amount to R31.88 billion. This amount is not aligned with figures in the MBRR schedules reported to municipal councils as explained above.
17. Provincial Treasury will continue to provide support to municipalities including guidance in respect of the Covid-19 response, support with mSCOA implementation, budget verifications, Annual Budget and In-Year Monitoring training, capacity building training initiatives, quarterly Chief Financial Officers' and Municipal Accountants Forums as well as facilitating the reduction of government debt owed to municipalities in conjunction with various government departments.
