REPLACEMENT OF THE KITSO APPLICATION (FOR BAS REPORTS) WITH BIZBRAIN

1. PURPOSE

To inform All Accounting Officers and Chief Financial Officers of the replacement of the KITSO application with BIZBRAIN effective 1st October 2019 and to communicate procedure on how to access the new BIZBRAIN application for access to the identical information previously available on KITSO.

2. BACKGROUND

The KITSO application has been used as a tool to assist Provincial Departments in tracing expenditure, displaying exception reports and detailed reports on entities. As part of identifying cost saving mechanisms, the Provincial Treasury has decided to discontinue the use of the KITSO application and make use of the in-house BIZBRAIN platform to provide the same functions as that of KITSO.

3. USER ACCESS PROCEDURES FOR NEW BIZBRAIN PLATFORM

As part of a procedure to ensure that all users accessing this new platform are indeed eligible to be granted access, it is expected that all current KITSO users confirm via our BAS helpdesk function to <u>Liezel.vanzyl@westerncape.gov.za</u> if they wish to have continued access to the new BIZBRAIN application.

The following is the procedure for new users on the BIZBRAIN platform:

- A Cel IT Request Form must be completed and signed;
- The signed application form must be forwarded to <u>Liezel.vanzyl@westerncape.gov.za</u> at the BAS helpdesk

Once the signed application has been processed, an URL link will be emailed to the approved user to direct them to the new BIZBRAIN application. It should be noted that the BIZBRAIN application does not require username and passwords as it is linked to an Active Directory.

4. USER ACCEPTANCE TESTING (UAT)

The Provincial Treasury acknowledges the criticality of having quality information systems and therefore intends to perform User Acceptance testing with all 13 departments during the month of September 2019 in order to ensure successful go live on 1st October 2019.

It is requested that during the User Acceptance Testing phase that departments avail the existing KITSO users to assist with comparing reports from the KITSO application with that of the new BIZBRAIN application to ensure correctness.

5. REQUEST

It is therefore the intention of this circular to request Accounting officers and accounting authorities to bring the contents above to the attention of all relevant officials in the departments.
