FIRST AMENDMENT TO NATIONAL TREASURY INSTRUCTION NO. 11 OF 2020/2021 REPORTING DATES

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this circular is to communicate the first amendment to National Treasury Instruction Note No. 11 of 2020/2021 (IN11) and to inform accounting officers/ accounting authorities of the reporting dates for the 2021/2022 financial year (hereto attached as Annexure A).

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 As indicated via National Treasury Instruction Note 11 of 2020/2021, all procurement transactions related to the emergency procurement for COVID-19 PPE items, fabric masks as well as other goods,

works and services that were procured to prevent an escalation of the national state of disaster or to alleviate, contain or minimise the effects of the Disaster must be reported to the Provincial Treasury as required by the National Treasury. This includes, inter alia, expenditure for quarantine and isolation services, humanitarian relief, amongst others.

2.2 As communicated via Treasury Circular 31 of 2020, the Provincial Treasury (PT) has defined a process to manage the reporting requirements for departments given that departments utilise the LOGIS and BAS legacy systems. Public Entities were required to manually capture the required information on the NT's template on a monthly basis and submit to the PT. The purpose of this process is to ensure the integrity of data reported to the NT and the information published in the Public Disclosure Report (PDR).

2.4 **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR 2021/22**

- 2.3 The first amendment to NTI 11 of 2020/2021 was issued with the intent to adjust and include the reporting dates for the 2021/2022 financial year.
- 2.4 Departments and public entities are required to continue reporting procurement transactions for the periods indicated in the below table by the deadlines provided by the PT:

2.5 The process as articulated in paragraph 4.4 of Treasury Circular 31 of 2020 is re-iterated and remains applicable to departments. Public Entities are required to manually capture the required information on the template on a monthly basis and submit to the PT.
