ADJUSTMENTS TO THE STANDARD CHART OF ACCOUNTS (SCOA) VERSION 5: CLASSIFICATION CIRCULAR (CC) 32

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this circular is to inform government departments' financial practitioners of the changes made to the Standard Chart of Accounts (SCOA COR 5) in the second quarter of 2020/21 financial year (1 July 2020 to 30 September 2020) which was issued 06 November 2020.

2. FUND SEGMENT

Changes to the Fund Segment have been aligned to the published Adjusted Appropriation Bill and Adjusted Division of Revenue Bills for 2020 and distributed to departments. Major changes relate to fund allocations made in respect of the Presidential Employment Intervention (PEI). The PEI is a specific and exclusively appropriated fund allocation and the chart changes have been aligned to reflect it as such.

3. INFRASTRUCTURE SEGMENT

- 3.1 A new item for Inventory assets for distribution: Biological assets was added under Non-Infrastructure: Current; which is linked to the same item in the Item segment.
- 3.2 The posting name for the asset item is N/I S/A CUR:INV ASS DST BIO ASST with segment number 128.

4. ITEM SEGMENT

- 4.1 Computer Service: A new Sita Electronic Delivery System has been added under Computer Services category for payments made specifically to SITA where PERSAL salary slips will be delivered to recipients via email. The posting name for the item is **SITA ELECTRON DOC DEL SYS (EDD)** with **segment number 5253.**
- 4.2 Inventory Assets for Distribution: A new item Inventory Assets for Distribution: Biological Assets has been added under this category for the purchase of biological assets such as cattle for distribution to households. The posting name for the asset item is **INV ASSTS DSTR: BIOLOGICAL ASSETS** with segment number 5301.
- 4.3 Transfers & Subsidies: Details of transfers and subsidies in the SCOA have been aligned to details approved in the ENE and EPRE on transfers and subsidies. These are not individually listed in this classification circular as they are department specific.

5. REQUIRED

- 5.1 Departments are requested to ensure that, where necessary, the PERSAL and BAS links are updated in order to avoid PERSAL-BAS Interface exceptions.
