STATUTORY PRICE INCREASE 2022: CONTRACT WCPT-TR 01/2017/2018: FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSVERSAL PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES TO THE WESTERN CAPE GOVERNMENT EFFECTIVE 2 MARCH 2023

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this communiqué is to inform institutions of the statutory price increase of the transversal security framework agreement for Western Cape institutions for the period 2 March 2023 to 28 February 2027.

2. SECURITY FRAMEWORK RATES MARCH 2023 TO FEBRUARY 2027

- 2.1 The Minister of Employment and Labour announced that the Agreement (annexed hereto marked "Annexure A"), was concluded in the National Bargaining Council for the Private Security Sector, which is binding in terms of section 31 of the Labour Relations Act of 1995, gazetted on 30 December 2022.
- 2.2 The Agreement is binding on employers and employees in the industry, with effect from 2 March 2023 and shall remain in force until 28 February 2027. This necessitates the revision of the framework agreement current contractual average pricing rates, as approved by the Head of Treasury (HOT) in 2022.
- 2.3 The Provincial Treasury adjusted the mutually agreed monthly prices in accordance with the abovementioned agreement. The increases are reflected hereunder in relation to the service types and in terms of urban and rural areas of the framework:
