### Mission



## **Values**



# **Ensuring smooth transition post 2021 Local Government Elections**

#### The Department of Local Government:



provided support and legal guidance on the filling of senior management positions.

facilitated workshops to capacitate local government practitioners to engage, interpret and implement legal prescripts.

worked in collaboration with the Department of Co-operative Governance and the South African Local Government Association (SALGA) Western Cape providing support to municipalities to ensure readiness for the implementation of the Local Government Municipal Staff Regulations and Guidelines.

conducted diagnostic assessments on the Section 154 Support Plans to strengthen the governance, administration and service delivery.

## **Training and capacity-building**

### The Department of Local Government:

rolled out the Municipal Minimum Competency (MMC) Training to councillors to enhance knowledge and skills.



for a sixth consecutive year, received recognition from the Department of Co-operative Governance for good practices in monitoring and supporting municipalities to ensure compliance with the implementation of the Municipal Property Rates Act,

conducted training for councillor seasonal schools and municipal middle managers, in partnership with the Hanns Seidel Foundation.




implemented the

#### The Department of Local Government:




supported municipalities with training ward committees, developing and reviewing Ward Committee Operational Plans to strengthen the functionality of ward committees.




## **Collaborative Planning**


Several citizenfocused catalytic projects were launched to improve people's lives and their lived experiences. The Department will continue to utilise this platform for integrated and sustainable service delivery.
