HAVE GRADE 9, NQF LEVEL 1 ABET LEVEL 4 OR SIMILAR EDUCATION LEVEL

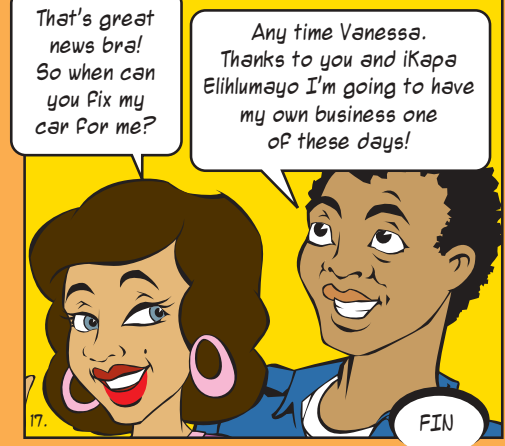
That's me! I'm sure I can get one of these iKapa study loans!
