August sees the celebration of National Women's Day, and this display is all about celebrating women. There are many words we can use to describe the women in our lives, and that is just what we've done. We decided to use one word for each letter in the word *Women* to describe them. Of course, you are more than welcome to use your own words, these are just examples!

To complete the display, you will need:

- scissors
- Pritt
- cardboard (colour of your choice)
- black Khoki
- glitter (if you have)
- Prestik
- A1-cardboard
- templates.

Method

Using the template provided, print and cut out the letters. Using Prestik, stick the letters to the A1 board. Then, using the black Khoki, write (try to be creative) the words you would describe women as around the word *Women*. Then print and cut the template of the silhouette of a woman, and arrange it at the bottom of the A1-board. To add some colour and interest to the display we used glitter on some of the words we chose, with flowers cutouts surrounding the main part of the display.

We hope that you take inspiration from this display, and spoil the special women in your lives on National Women's Day.
