Key defining features/characteristics:

- Intergovernmental dialogue between municipalities and government
- Implementation (Project) orientation/focus

Objectives of IDP Indaba 2


- To discuss sector departmental projects that will be implemented in a specific locality in a municipality
- To agree on time frames, support needs, and resource allocation
- To influence sector APP preparation process (strengthening the bottom up component)
- To ensure that municipal IDPs reflects sector projects (strengthening the top down component)

Progress to date

Municipal one-one visits have been concluded in all municipalities in the province. Support of MM and their management teams is commendable.

IDP Indaba preparatory Meeting with selected National sector departments was held on the 28 November 2012 in Pretoria.

19/29 MM signed off priorities' templates have been received to date.

IDP Indaba dates were confirmed with all relevant stakeholders.

The PSO 10: Indaba Working Group 04 December 2012- Process deadlines were agreed to in terms of submission of sector responses to municipal priorities.

Ensuring quality: "Information Management"

Criteria for the identification of credible municipal priority issues and projects:

- ☐ Identified as a priority in the IDP
- ☐ Tangible, i.e. a project/project related need
- ☐ Signed off by a Municipal Manager



Ensuring quality: "Information Management"

Criteria for credible sector departmental inputs:

- □ How municipal inputs have been filtered in APPs and/or sector departmental implementation processes
- ☐ Why projects/needs from municipal inputs were not included and provide reasons why not
- Whether projects/needs may be included in future
- ☐ Include signed off responses by HoDs



Lessons learnt: "so what is different?"

- a. Preparation commencing 5 months ahead of time
- b. Expansion of the Spatial Mapping/budgeting from 5 to all sector departments
- c. Ensure credible municipal inputs signed off by Municipal Managers
- d. Move away from intangible "agreements" to project related outputs demonstrating real impact, **no more "fluff"**
- e. Ensure **credible provincial sector departmental inputs** that are signed off by HoDs
- f. Increased mobilization of national sector departments
- g. Increased mobilization of Heads of Departments
