ITEM 2: AUDITOR GENERAL

AUDIT OUTCOMES

- Mayor, MM, CFO and Audit Officer to engage with AG on one on one basis.
- Matter to be tabled at the MinMay. The working group to report progress made to the next PCF.
- 6 weeks prior to PCF, Premier, AG, West Coast and Swartland to work on a generic user friendly template. (Meeting to include CFOs)
- Mayors and MM must continue to do the their oversight role,
- Premier, Ministers, Mayors and Senior Officials must become the "voice of clean audit outcomes"



ITEM 2: AUDITOR GENERA L

AUDIT OUTCOMES

- Municipalities are advised to introduce a bill that regulates the involvement of officials (administrators, councilors, etc) in doing business with municipalities
- Exchequer Act to be embraced by next year, Presentation to be done by Minster Winde at next PCF



INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT PLANNING: INDABA

Provincial and Municipal Perspective:

- IDP INDABA 2 received positive feedback
- DLG to take note of all recommendations made by presenters
- DLG to ensure that stakeholders that require further engagement are followed up
- By February 2014 all Municipalities to present Midterm Review of IDP.
- IDP process plan, Public Participation to be discussed at MinMay / MinMay Tech Forum



Financial Viability and Sustainability – MinMay

- Provincial Treasury to consult with National Treasury on the Amendments Preferential Procurement Policy Regulations.
- Unfunded Mandates.

- Eskom (reticulation and debtors).
- Fiscal Model currently outdated and needs to be reviewed develop a new approach to support and fund municipalities.
- Excessive Compliance: National Treasury to work with Municipalities to assess and reduce the costs of compliance.



Overlap of IGR Forums

- Finalisation of an IGR Framework. [Audit & Recommendations].
- Coordination Framework for questionnaires.
- Protocol: Entry point into Municipalities.



Master Implementation Plan Western Cape

- DLG to liaise with the CEI in respect of revival of the Local Government ICT Forum,
- Municipalities to nominate officials to participate in the Western Cape Broadband Strategy, and
- Contact details of DEDAT officials be forwarded to all Municipal Managers



Jobs Fund and Employment Fund

- Municipalities to contact Development Bank of South Africa [DBSA], and
- DBSA envisaged visiting all municipalities in respect of current phase of applications to the fund.
