USB Training/Support Status

Moveable Asset Management: Supply Chain Management

- Training material was compiled as per the 2011/2012 TOR and presented to a selected group of Municipalities as part of a pilot training session.
- The following groups (groupings) were identified with indicated identified training needs:
- ✓ SCM Practitioners: focus on how to do;
- ✓ SCM End Users: Understanding the SCM function;
- SCM Magement: Understanding the strategic role of SCM within the organisation; and Special focus on IDP, SDBIP and Annual- and Adjustment Budget.
- It was acknowledged by the Directorate: MAM that the material needs to be brought in line based on the training needs identified above and to give effect to the Advancement of a SCM academic curriculum.
- The new TOR for 2012/2013 is in line with this approach and still in process of finalising.











Local Government Finance Training: Municipal Budgets and IYMs

- Training material was compiled as per the 2011/2012 TOR and presented to a selected group of Municipalities as part of a pilot training session.
- The development of the training material is completed and adjusted with inputs from reference group.
- The target groups were also identified with differential experience and training needs but which will be managed in training workshops.
- The new TOR for 2012/2013 year is finalised and still in process of review and signing-off by PT.











Rural & Agricultural Research Project

- Baseline Study is 100% complete and the inclusion of interview outcomes into report is 80% complete.
- In process of collecting additional HR statistics within the 8 Municipal Areas.
- Overall Report is 70% complete and will be finalised by end of the month.

Pre-determined Objectives

- PDO Maturity Assessments at Pilot Municipalities completed.
- Assessment outcomes documented and to be presented to the Pilot Municipalities fore feedback.
- Draft PDO Framework for Municipalities in the Western Cape completed and submitted to the Project Sponsor for feedback/comments.
- The new TOR for 2012/2013 year is finalised and still in process of review and signing-off











Corporate Governance Training:

- Training material was compiled as per the 2011/2012 TOR and presented to a selected group of Municipalities as part of a pilot training session.
