CHALLENGES FACED BY MUNICIPALITIES

- Municipalities faced with the vast sphere of legislations and need to keep abreast with latest legislative requirements
- Expected of Municipalities to keep-up with all the requirements
- There is no specific tool to assist municipalities to comply with applicable legislative requirements
- There is no tool to measure the level of compliance



KEY FEATURES OF THE COMPLIANCE MODEL

Key Features

- (i) Capable of measuring the performance of municipalities in complying with the applicable local government legislation and regulations;
- (ii) Programmed to monitor level of compliance by Municipalities;
- (iii) The Compliance Model is web-based;
- (iv) It can be tailored to the specific needs of a municipality, which will outline its own checklists and legislative requirements
- (v) Assigns responsibility to individuals with deadlines
- (vi) Reminder e-mails
- (vii) Programmed to provide a closing dates to promote a reporting culture and accurate reporting;



KEY FEATURES OF THE COMPLIANCE MODEL

Continuation of Key Features

- (viii) Functional for assurance providers to audit compliance levels
- (xi) Linked to all applicable legislation and regulations ie. A minimum of 16 pieces of relevant legislations is loaded on the system, with 24 available;
- (x) Capable of capturing reports on progress made regarding specific sections as well as attaching evidence of compliance;
- (xi) Programmed to develop various reports on attainment of required action and graphs to support reporting on compliance against legislative requirements;
- (xii) Loaded with strict security management; and
- (xiii) Maybe linked to a Provincial Portal for future monitoring by Department.



EXAMPLE OF REPORT PER MUNICIPAL OFFICIAL


